

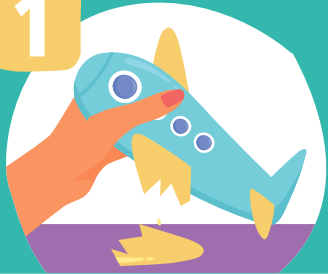


STEPS FOR



Toy Cleaning and Disinfection

1



Inspect & Collect

- ✓ Check toys for damage
- ✓ Remove toys from play area and take to cleaning and disinfection area

2



Clean

- ✓ Wash and scrub toys with soap and warm water
- ✓ Use small cleaning brushes to clean in hard-to-reach areas

3



Rinse

- ✓ Rinse with clean tap water

4



Dry

- ✓ Air dry or dry with a clean cloth

5



Disinfect*

- ✓ Use a Health Canada approved disinfectant. Follow manufacturer's instructions**

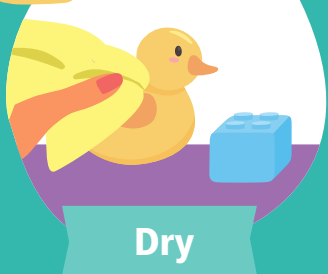

Rinse

- ✓ Rinse with clean tap water

Dry

- ✓ Air dry or dry with a clean cloth

8



Record

- ✓ Keep a record of when toys were cleaned and disinfected



*Dishwasher use is not the preferred method. If using dishwasher, ensure compliance with Ontario Food Premises Regulation R.R.O. 493/17. Do not use dishwasher to disinfect toys during an outbreak.

**Fully immerse toys in the disinfectant. For large toys, apply with a spray or cloth saturated with the disinfectant. Adhere to contact times as indicated on the product label.
