Barrie SCS Site Selection Advisory Committee - Monthly Update

November /2019

- The SCS Site Selection Advisory committee continues to meet every 2 weeks. A subcommittee has been formed to conduct a site search.
- CMHA has been identified as the lead applicant and operator for the proposed SCS. SMDHU will be the co-applicant.
- The Committee has agreed on the Ward 2 boundaries to guide the site search. The boundary map has been posted to the SMDHU website.



- The SCS subcommittee for the site search is in the process of creating a package for potential landlords that highlights what a SCS offers, and why there is need for a SCS in Ward 2 Barrie. The subcommittee is exploring options and plans to enlist a local realtor for assistance.
- The SCS Site Selection Advisory finalized the Site Selection Criteria document based on Health Canada, Ministry of Health application criteria and membership recommendations. The Site Selection Criteria has been posted to the SMDHU website.



 The SCS Site Selection Advisory committee has reviewed the Waterloo SCS Consultation report and is in the process of planning the Barrie community engagement and consultations. An online survey will be used to gather feedback from all Barrie residents on the limited number of viable sites that are chosen for review. Neighbourhood consultations will also take place for these sites, similar to the process that Waterloo Region utilized. Details of this consultation process are still in the planning stages.
